Collective Bargaining

The Collective Agreement (CA) is an agreement between the employer (RETSD, represented by the Manitoba School Boards Association) and employees (RETTA, represented by the Manitoba Teachers' Society) to:

- promote and improve the working relations between the two parties:
- to establish an acceptable salary schedule and other conditions of employment resulting from the operation of said agreement; and
- to provide a basis for both parties to improve the professional and academic services rendered to the school children and the citizens of RETSD.

It is essential to know your CA so that you adhere to it and the employer appropriately applies it.

Personal Professional Development Fund (PPDF)

The Personal Professional Development Fund was created as a result of a Letter of Intent between the Board of Trustees and the Association. The fund is intended to stimulate and provide financial assistance for personal professional development of professional staff in the Division who are members of the Association covered by the Collective Agreement of the River East Transcona Teachers' Association.

This assistance will normally be used to fund:

- educational leave and attendance at conferences, seminars, and workshops
- Non-credit courses
- professional programs organized by outside agencies

Although the fund is intended to assist teachers in their personal professional development, it is recognized that this development will be of a kind that is beneficial to the Division.
